



Background

- In February 2020, Mayor Eric Garcetti nominated attorney, Capri Maddox to lead the newlyestablished Civil and Human Rights Department (CHRD).
- CHRD is focused on reducing bias and injustices while leveling the playing field through equity initiatives, upward mobility programming, and our work with the Human Relations Commission, the Commission on the Status of Women, and the Civil and Human Rights Commission (CHRC).
- CHRD also has quasi-judicial authority to address the longstanding discrimination impacting underserved communities which denies equal treatment in private commerce, education, employment, and housing.
