# Citywide

### • Recent & New State Housing Legislation

- These Senate and Assembly Bills are set to affect housing in terms of changes to Parking, Affordability, Density Bonus, CEQA, and ADUs.

# • Proposed Oil and Gas Drilling Ordinance Update

- This proposed ordinance would ban existing and future oil and gas drilling activities in the City
- Was approved by the Planning and Land Use Committee (PLUM) on November 1, 2022
- Was unanimously approved by the City Planning Commission on September 22, 2022

# Transportation Demand Management Ordinance Update

- Proposed update was considered and approved by City Planning Commission on September 22, 2022
- Was approved by the PLUM Committee on November 1, 2022
- The proposed TDM Ordinance update will reduce single-driver car trips and vehicle miles traveled by increasing transportation options and accessibility throughout the City. The proposed update also requires all

new development projects over a certain size to implement strategies such as supporting transit, telecommuting, walking, carshare, and other sustainable travel options that reduce vehicle trips.

#### Online Application System

- As part of an effort to improve customer loyalty and expand access to City Planning services, City Planning has improved the OAS by now including certain specialized discretionary services.
- New additions: Beverage and Entertainment Streamlined (BESt) and Wireless Telecommunications Units
- In the coming months, City Planning will offer all discretionary planning approvals online via OAS

### • Wildlife Pilot Study

- The proposed Wildlife Ordinance will be heard by the City Planning Commission (CPC) on November 17, 2022

# Hillside Construction Regulations Virtual Info Sessions and Public Hearings

- HCR Supplemental Use District addresses the unique challenges created by construction activities within hillside communities that have constrained access and geotechnical sensitivities
- City Planning Commission recommended approval on November 3, 2022
- Maps of the proposed new areas, as well as a Fact Sheet and Frequently Asked Questions are available on City Planning's website

# Boyle Heights Community Plan Update

- Boyle Heights Community Plan Update
- o Virtual Info Session and Public Hearing held on October 27, 2022
- o Virtual Office Hours available through November 3, 2022
- o Draft EIR comment period concluded on October 11, 2022, at 5 pm
- Overview of EIR; Spanish Version & Public Hearing Notice

#### • Slauson Corridor Transit Neighborhood Plan (TNP)

- The Slauson Corridor TNP is a <u>work program</u> that plans for green jobs, expands affordable housing opportunities
- Also promotes path-oriented building design next to LA Metro's future Rail-to-Rail Active Transportation Corridor (i.e., bicycle and pedestrian path)
- Approved by PLUM Committee on November 1, 2022

#### South LA CPIO Amendment

- Proposed amendments would create a new administrative process to review projects within a new "CPIO Protected Unit Area" whereby residential projects would be subject to existing CPIO Residential Subarea development standards
- New, additional provisions would require the replacement of affordable housing and delay demolitions
- Tentatively scheduled for CPC on 11/17

### • Westside Community Plan Update

- Preparing revised General Plan land Use (GPLU) StoryMap, Plan Policy Text, and New Zones
- Received and reviewed over 100 applications from the public to join the Westside Community Plan Advisory Group (WCPAG) in June and July 2022
- Rolled out Westside Community Plan Advisory Group (WCPAG) application in May 2022
- Conducted outdoor field site visits in Palms-Mar Vista-Del Rey, Venice,
  West LA, and Westchester-Playa del Rey in March and April 2022

#### Regional

• Westwood Village Specific Plan Amendment

- Adopted by Council on Friday, September 30, 2022
- Fact Sheet, Ordinance, and Council File
- Adopted amendment amends provisions related to definitions, limitations on uses, parking, and introduces a new administrative review process for eligible sign projects and changes of use

# <u>Downtown Community Plan Update</u>

- The City Planning Commission recommended approval of the Downtown Los Angeles Community Plan and New Zoning Code on September 23, 2021
- The CPC's Recommended Draft of the Downtown Plan and New Zoning Code and letter of determination can be found here.
- As requested by Council District 14, City Planning has prepared an economic feasibility study for a mandatory onsite affordable housing requirement (inclusionary zoning) that may be considered by PLUM
- Public Comments to be considered by PLUM may be submitted <u>here</u>.
- Next steps: PLUM Committee and Council approval
