The Los Angeles Neighborhood Council Coalition (XXXXXX Neighborhood Council) has reviewed the Controller's initial analysis on many of these funds and supports his preliminary recommendations for their disposition, as noted on [www.lacontroller.org/idlefunds](http://www.lacontroller.org/idlefunds) . We also support the Controller's efforts to develop proposed policies and procedures for special funds, reviewing the legal limitations that restrict their use, and determining how best the City can leverage these funds to enhance delivery of City services.
