[Note: Deadline for NCs to file CIS extended 45 days to 10/7/18]

<u>12-1681-S3</u>	To Health, Education, and Neighborhood Councils Committee Motion (Ryu - Cedillo) - Relative to recommendations for improvements in the subdivision process of Neighborhood Councils. [Note: Adopted by City Council on 9/5/18 to draft ordinance]
