<u>19-1412</u> To Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee

Motion (Ryu - Buscaino - Harris-Dawson) relative to requesting the City Attorney, with the assistance of relevant City departments, to draft an Ordinance that would authorize the Los Angeles City Council to declare a Local Homelessness State of Emergency, renewed annually and which would provide full authority to the Mayor to site homeless housing, re-zone select parcels for the use of homeless housing.
