Program Overview

- Qualified single-family residential customers in Disadvantaged Communities can upgrade their front yard for **FREE**
- Funded by the Urban Community Drought Relief Grant from the California Department of Water Resources (DWR)
- LEAP launched on **August 26, 2025** and will end in **Winter 2026**
- LEAP is offered first come, first served to qualified applicants
- Apply online today through your LADWP account (*paper applications are available upon request*)



How to Qualify?

LADWP customers may qualify if they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- ✓ ☒ Live in a single-family residence within a Disadvantaged Community (DAC) as defined by DWR ([DAC Mapping Tool](#))
- ✓ ☒ Have between 1,000 and 3,000 square feet of live green grass in the front yard
- ✓ ☒ Are the Property Owner or have permission from the Property Owner
- ✓ ☒ Agree to the LEAP Terms and Conditions

Free Services

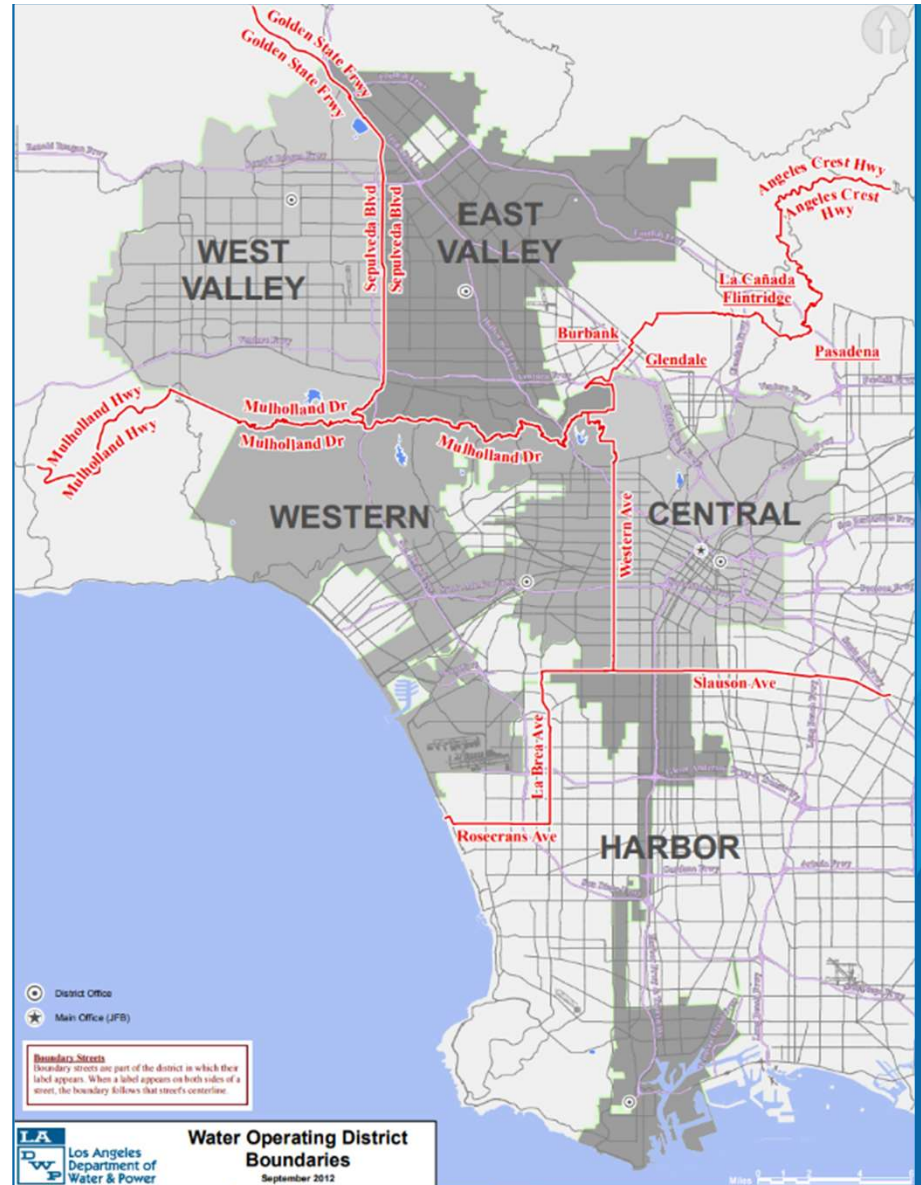
Free services may include the following:

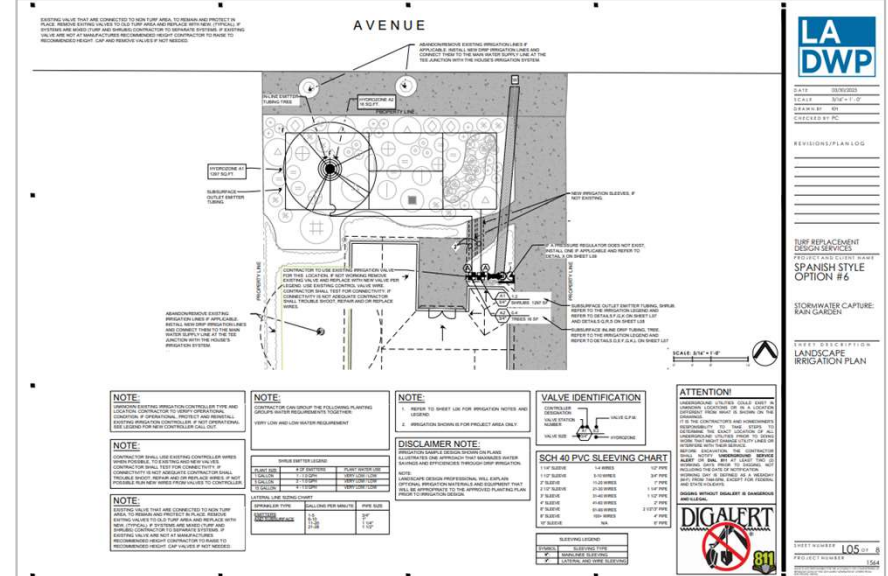
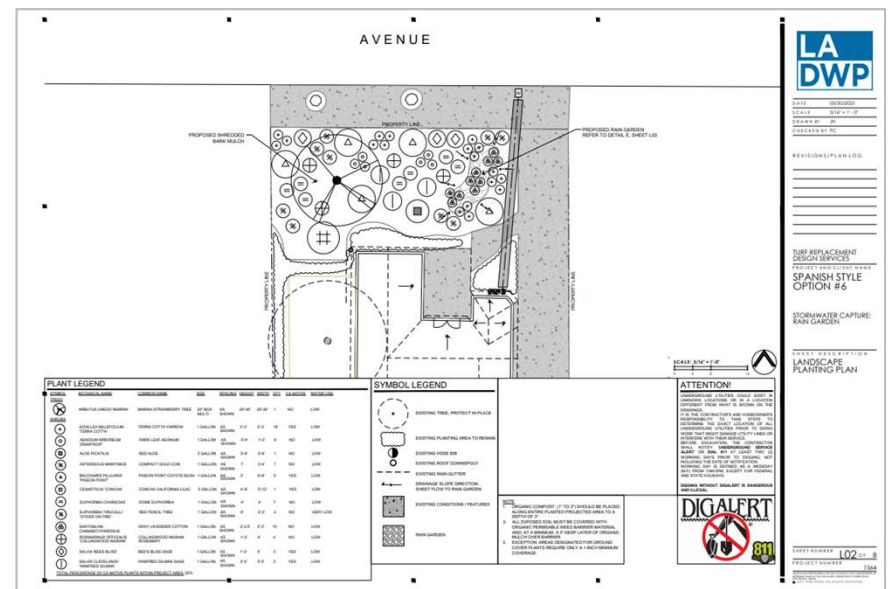
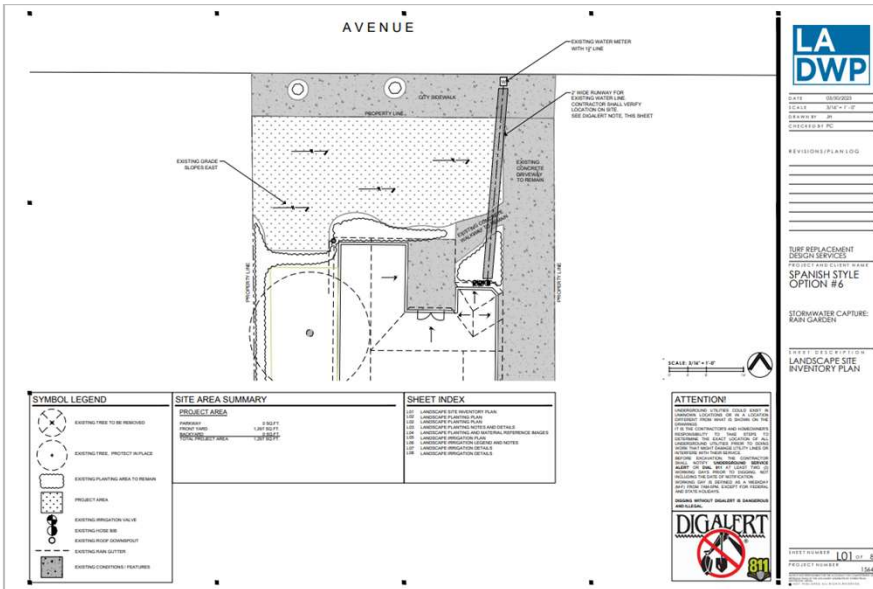
- Turf removal in their front yard
- Installation of CA Friendly landscaping **or** high-efficiency sprinklers
- Installation of a stormwater capture feature
- Conversion to drip irrigation
- Installation of a weather-based irrigation controller (if applicable)
- Installation of a smart water use monitoring device (if applicable)



LADWP Water Districts

- Eligible customers can choose between 5 design templates depending on their Water District
- Contractors will also be assigned depending on the Water District
