 - a. Discussion and possible action Neighborhood Council Funding: The Mayor's proposed Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget includes a \$25,000 annual allocation for each Neighborhood Council, a \$7,000 reduction from the current amount of \$32,000. It also provides for the rollover of all unexpended funds from this fiscal year to the following one. Over 20 years ago, NCs were allocated \$50,000 annually with the ability to rollover up to \$100,000. Since then, due to cost-of-living increases and inflation, a dollar of purchasing power now requires \$1.76.
 MOTION: The _______ Neighborhood Council requests that the Mayor and City Council restore the amount annually allocated to at least the current \$32,000. The ______ NC supports the rollover of all unexpended funds from this fiscal year to next year, as proposed in the Mayor's Budget. A Community Impact Statement will be filed to Council File 25-0600, Budget Proposal Fiscal Year 2025-2026.
 - b. Discussion and possible action on the proposed extensions to SB 411 updates. Assembly Bill 467 (Fong), link to the <u>bill text</u> The bill was amended and unanimously voted out of the Assembly Local Government Committee. It is awaiting its third reading and vote by the full Assembly.
