- To Health, Education, Neighborhoods, Parks, Arts, and River Committee

  Motion (Martinez Ryu et al.) relative to a request to the Board of Recreation and
  Parks Commissioners to name the Sepulveda Basin Wildlife Reserve in memory of Park
  Ranger Captain Albert E. Torres, in recognition of his distinguished career of service to
  the Department of Recreation and Parks and to the people and City of Los Angeles.

  Motion (Rodriguez Martinez Blumenfield) relative to instructing the Department of
